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ANNOUNCEMENT FROM THE PRESIDENT

The war in Ukraine demonstrates, once again how difficult we find it to develop the skills we need to live together in peace. While international leaders talk about “transforming education”, Graines de Paix spent 2021 doing exactly that. In all our programmes, we have made the link between education and peace in working towards the societal goals of achieving personal fulfilment, preventing violence and drivers of radicalisation, and developing peace between all people and the planet. Over the past year, we have focused on groups experiencing discrimination. We have also extended our geographic and demographic coverage by designing, adapting and replicating certain projects to reach those most in need.

Empowering girls

Recognising the immediate and future value of our unique approach, educational practitioners in Côte d'Ivoire and Benin have deepened their commitment to Graines de Paix. In Benin, we have started work on the *Better Schools for Girls* programme. Following its success in Côte d'Ivoire, the programme is setting out to transform attitudes towards girls, and teaching practices for all children, to create a climate of peace in classrooms and in families.

Building national cohesion in Côte d'Ivoire

Côte d'Ivoire's educational strategy involves enabling children from Islamic schools to integrate into and succeed in the public education system. To facilitate this, our team was commissioned to transform teaching methods and approaches (e.g. to reduce rote learning). Children from 340 Islamic schools are now enjoying a more respectful and empowering education, that is sharpening their reflective and emotional skills and helping them to reach their full potential. Our human rights-based approaches to education are now recognised as essential levers for overcoming hesitation towards societal integration.

Finding solutions at every stage of schooling

In 2021, we also extended our work in Benin to pre-school level, started to deliver the *Living Well Together* programme in secondary schools in Switzerland, and continued to roll out the *AdoGoZen* programme for young people. All of these with the aim of providing children and young people everywhere in the world with inclusive, high quality and empowering education, throughout their time at school.

Working with families

Our final major achievement was the expansion of activities for parental and community engagement in our programmes, to consolidate the work delivered in schools. The launch of the book *À la poursuite de Léon et ses émotions*, which enables children to explore the world of emotional skills with their parents, reinforced our efforts in this area.

We are working towards the next stage of growth, so we can increase support from international donors to deliver full quality education that equips students with the key skills needed for the 21st century, among these being self-esteem, relational and intercultural skills, reflection and discernment skills. These skills are vital in taking action for the planet and in easing tensions among all people, skills for peace that we make explicit.

- Continuously innovate our teaching approaches for the full educational system, and to engage society.

We commit to educating generations of children to become resilient and engaged young people who will respond to the challenges of the future by using the competencies and life skills developed over the course of their schooling.

This expansion will be achieved by adapting our approaches to new contexts, by reinforcing existing partnerships and by creating new ones. We will continue to build our structure and our resources so we can respond to these demands.

“ Workshops that are truly relevant to young people's experience.



Sarah El Ghazal is an educator and facilitator in the town of Ecublens. She is the Graines de Paix facilitator mentor for AdoGoZen.

What do young people get out of the AdoGoZen programme?

This project really reflects the day-to-day reality I see with young people. It provides a way of addressing the issue of violence and harassment in a more fun way than at school. It facilitates discussion and peer-to-peer counselling, builds self-esteem, and helps to form bonds with friends and adults. It teaches young people to show trust, to dare to talk about their problems.

What social impact can it have?

At a societal scale, we need more of these initiatives, so we can sow the seeds far and wide to raise a generation that is better prepared to live a life free of violence.

Can you give us an example?

Just before a workshop, there was a clash within one group. During the workshop, I was able to discuss the importance of connection – how we can understand, when someone hurts or disappoints us, what may be behind it. I was pretty much able to solve the problem and defuse the conflict. When they left, the girls were talking to each other and went off to eat together. This anecdote proves that the workshops are completely relevant to the young peoples' lives. They help them to address these problems in a safe way; they let the young people take a step back and not fall back into a spiral of violence.

I'm interested to see how the project will develop, and I'd really like more young people to be able to benefit from it!

Benin

Léon et ses émotions exhibition : already adopted by 4,000 students.

The roll-out of the *Léon et ses émotions* exhibition was highly successful in Benin. No less than 60 schools – 4,104 children – had the opportunity to discover the exhibition in 2021, with promising feedback. The exhibition was delivered by a group of facilitators from Educo, previously trained by the Graines de Paix educational team (in Geneva and Benin).

Based on evaluation of a set of indicators before and after the activity, the exhibition enabled the children to:

- Develop their emotional skill set
- Better recognise emotions and understand the needs associated with them.
- Be able to come up with de-escalation strategies for themselves and others.

The exhibition is now available for a roll-out in all countries. .

Quality Education and Prevention of Violence: first intervention a success!

In 2019, Graines de Paix launched its **first intervention in Benin**, financially supported by the SDC (Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation), the Smartpeace Foundation and our donors through crowdfunding. It is time to take stock of this large-scale programme, which will have now reached over **150,000 children**.

Aim

Train teachers and parents to foster a more peaceful and more inclusive climate, that favours the fulfilment of all children as well as their academic success

Where

In Alibori in the north (primary school level) and in Littoral and Atlantic in the south (pre-school level)

When

2019-2021

How

- 4,500 teachers trained
- 150,000 children benefited
- 2'400 parents made aware
- 300,000 reached by the media campaign



Outcomes observed in schools and amongst parents

- Numerous trainers and teachers testified to a transformation in their relations with their students, their colleagues, and their own families.
- The activities eased their relationships, helped them to take better account of the needs of children and of those around them, and motivated them to become proponents of the culture of peace.
- The teachers can better recognize, identify and define violent situations.
- The level of violence in the classroom has been reduced: when the general rules are not followed, corporal or verbal punishment has been replaced by community service chores such as sweeping, weeding, or watering the plants.
- Teachers can identify discrimination and consider it unacceptable.
- Overall, teachers adopt an inclusive, firm, and caring stance. They better recognize the needs of the children, get them to participate more, and are more supportive and encouraging.
- Parents have become aware of the consequences of violence in education. They testify to a change in their practices, notably in establishing a firm and caring environment.



My practices and attitude have changed a lot since the training I undertook with Graines de Paix.

I respect the rights of the children, and thanks to the class charter developed with the participation of the students, order, and discipline reign in the classroom. I no longer use corporal punishment and each of the students is empowered.

My students are no longer scared to actively participate, and I question everyone without religious or ethnic bias.

With hands-on activities, I encourage children to express their feelings, which wasn't the case before my training.

I have learnt a new way of teaching, using positive education, and I am better equipped to teach by making all the students work in groups. They ask me questions and I direct them to think of the answers. Those who started from a low level have now started getting good results.

In routine activities, the students understand each other better and understand the cultures of the different ethnicities. They easily learn new words and the origin of names. They attend school regularly and get good results.

Quality Education in Islamic Schools

In Côte d'Ivoire, over 350,000 children follow an informal educational curriculum offered by private Muslim denominational schools called *Structures Islamiques d'Education*. In 2021, Graines de Paix was chosen by UNICEF to support the Ministry of National Education and Literacy (MENA) in implementing the national strategy to integrate children from Islamic schools into formal mainstream education. This project capitalises on Graines de Paix's expertise developed over the past 9 years in Côte d'Ivoire and its sensitive approach based on human values.





In this original activity book, *À la poursuite de Léon et ses émotions*, children are **actively involved** and exercise their imagination in each scene. Exploring deep in the rainforest, Leon the chameleon comes face-to-face with a spider...

Is he surprised by this unexpected encounter?
 Is he happy to have found a friend?
 Or is he frightened by its long hairy legs?
 It's up to the child to decide!

In following the little chameleon through eight beautiful landscapes, the child looks for clues and invents wonderful stories. Each re-reading gives rise to a new script and in-depth discussions. This helps the child to **better recognize, understand and calm their emotions and those of others**, so they can feel good in their head and their heart.





En notre qualité d'organe de révision, nous avons contrôlé les premiers comptes annuels (bilan, compte de résultat, tableau de variation et annexe) de la Fondation GRAINES DE PAIX pour l'exercice arrêté au 31 décembre 2021.

La responsabilité de l'établissement des comptes annuels incombe au Conseil de fondation alors que notre mission consiste à contrôler ces comptes. Nous attestons que nous remplissons les exigences légales d'agrément et d'indépendance.

Notre contrôle a été effectué selon la Norme suisse relative au contrôle restreint. Cette norme requiert de planifier et de réaliser le contrôle de manière telle que des anomalies significatives dans les comptes annuels puissent être constatées. Un contrôle restreint englobe principalement des auditions, des opérations de contrôle analytiques ainsi que des vérifications détaillées appropriées des documents disponibles dans l'entreprise contrôlée. En revanche, des vérifications des flux d'exploitation et du système de contrôle interne ainsi que des auditions et d'autres opérations de contrôle destinées à détecter des fraudes ne font pas partie de ce contrôle.
